Member Code of Conduct

Introduction

The intention of this document is to establish clear and acceptable behavior expectations for the Elly Bay Pool and facility for members and guests. It is not intended to restrict the rights of anyone but rather to ensure that all members and guests can expect to be treated with respect while enjoying our facility.

Code of Conduct

All members and guests will:

- 1) Be 21 years of age or older to enter, and present a valid driver's license.
- 2) Be aware that all bags and purses will be subject to search upon entry.
- 3) Adhere to the Elly Bay dress code. Swim suits are required for entry. Wet suits must be dried before entering buildings.
- 4) Not engage in any form of sexual, racial, or religious discrimination or harassment.
- 5) Respect the rights of other guests as well as Elly Bay and Flannagan's Dublin staff.
- 6) Not conduct themselves in any rude or immoral behavior, including the use of profane language, gestures, insults, inappropriate public displays of affection, or other such behavior.
- 7) Not be allowed to bring outside food and drink into Elly Bay or Flannagan's Dublin.
- 8) Abide by all state and local laws and regulations, including the possession of any illegal substance and weapons on the property.
- 9) Be prohibited from diving and jumping. Splashing and squirting other guests are not allowed.
- 10) Not be allowed the use of rafts, inflatables, balls and pool toys in the pool or pool area.
- 11) Use appropriate entry and exit points to enter and leave the pool area.

Seasonal Hours of Operation

Monday-Friday 12pm-6pm (Last admission 5pm)
Saturday/Sunday 12pm-7pm (Last admission 6pm)

*Please note: Elly Bay membership does not provide access to ticketed special events.

As an Elly Bay seasonal member, you may purchase a \$10 day pass for up to (2) guests. You will be responsible for their adherence to the Member Code of Conduct. If guests violate the Code of Conduct, they will be asked to leave and the violation will be brought to the Elly Bay Membership Committee for review.

Resolution of Violations

Should a violation take place, it will be brought forward to the Elly Bay Membership Committee. Disciplinary action will be determined by the membership committee and will vary on a case by case basis. Penalties may range from probation to revocation of membership. In all cases should there be damage to property, monetary restitution will be mandatory to continue membership.
